In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however, is achool is pursuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to avoid any difficulty for the purpose of admission /registration/ obtaining loan/renewal of various safety certificates from appropriate state authorities.

Therefore, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on details/date submitted by school in online application for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

- The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
- The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
- The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the Stat appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer sed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per
- The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable plan in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
- The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy there of for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. http://cbseacsdemic.nic.m/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly. 5
